
# Teachers' Resources: Hospitality, Leisure and Tourism

My Hospitality Life is an exciting careers programme developed to support young people's understanding of the hospitality industry. Students taking part benefit from a range of dynamic activities that better their awareness of the industry; helping them to explore why this is an exciting career, understand the job roles and opportunities, the education routes and they may also even gain contacts from higher education or industry.
